PROFESSIONAL REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to work as a registered nurse in the UK all nurses trained overseas must apply to work in the UK.

- I. Nurses must provide evidence that they are a registered nurse or registered mental health nurse and licenced to practice as nurses in their home country (Kenya)
- II. Nurses must provide certificate that confirms they have sat for the International English Language Test System (IELTS). In this particular English test one must
 - At least 7.0 in the listening and reading sections.
 - At least 7.0 in the writing and speaking sections.
 - At least 7.0 overall

III. Nurses must pass Computer Based Test (CBT). The CBT is a multiple choice exam based on knowledge skills and attitude in a specific field in nursing. TRAVEL AWAY VISA CONSULTANTS will organize that you do the exam in our premises. The CBT too must be passed.

IV. A valid Kenyan passport is also a requirement for every applicant and copies of birth certificate
